Charles Patrick "Pat" Stuttle, age 75, of Mattoon, IL peacefully passed away surrounded by family on Friday, March 21, 2025, in Naples, FL.

A funeral service in his honor will be at 1:00 PM, Saturday, March 29, 2025, at Mitchell-Jerdan Funeral Home, located at 1200 Wabash Avenue, Mattoon, IL 61938; Reverend Steve Morgan will officiate. 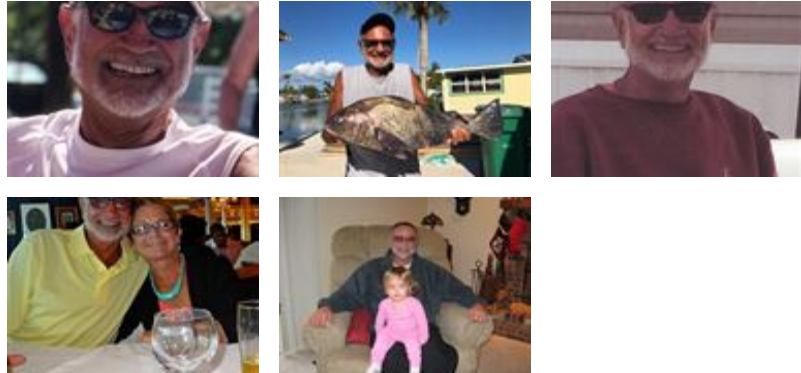
