Clarence L. Kersey, age 82, of Mattoon, passed away at 12:55 a.m., Sunday, February 3, 2013, at Heartland Christian Village, Neoga, IL. Funeral services honoring his life will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2013, at Mitchell-Jerdan Funeral Home, 1200 Wabash Avenue, Mattoon, IL. Reverend Dr. Ellen B. Moma will officiate. Burial will follow French Cemetery, Allenville, Illinois. Military Funeral Honors will be performed by Mattoon VFW Post #4325 and the Illinois National Guard.
