He was an avid fan of Major League Baseball; he followed the Baltimore Orioles and was a fan of both the Chicago Cubs and the St. Louis Cardinals. He was thrilled to attend Peoria Chiefs games with his family and would even stop along the roadside to catch a few innings of a Little League game if he happened upon one.
