MATTOON -- Genevieve Daily, age 89, of Mattoon, passed away at 6:14 p.m. Friday, July 8, 2005 at Provena Covenant Medical Center, Urbana.

Genevieve was born April 14, 1916 to Henry Clinton and Anna Hortenstine Fleenor. She graduated from Gays school and Mattoon High School. She then attended James Millikin University in Decatur, Illinois, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the School of Music. She was a teacher at Longfellow Junior High School in Mattoon for some time, and then gave violin lessons at her home.

Genevieve married W. Elgin Daily September 21, 1940 at St. Louis, Missouri and became a farm homemaker. She is survived by her husband, Elgin; two sisters, Virginia Barrow, her twin, of Mattoon and Mary Ruth Boyd of Gays. Nieces, Rita Getz of Quicksburg, Virginia, Rebecca Barrow of Mattoon and Alice Deininger of Decatur also survive.

After retirement, Genevieve and Elgin traveled quite extensively, and she pursued her hobby of genealogy. Genevieve was a member of the Governor Edward Coles Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Daughters of the American Colonists and the Illinois Society of the United States Daughters of 1812. She was also a member of the National Society of Magna Charta Dames, was a charter member of the Moultrie County Historical and Genealogical Society and belonged to other genealogical organizations. She was a lifelong member of Pleasant Grove Baptist Church at Cooks Mills
