Jerry W. Beaumont, age 85 of Mattoon, IL passed away peacefully in his sleep on Thursday, September 12, 2024.

Visitation and a funeral service in his honor will be held on Thursday, September 19, 2024, at the First Presbyterian Church, 10 Charleston Avenue, Mattoon, IL. The visitation will start at 9:30 AM and the service at 11:00 AM. Reverend Matthew Froeschle will officiate. Interment will be held at a later date at Dodge Grove Cemetery in Mattoon, IL.
