Ray was a graduate of both Lake Land College and Eastern Illinois University where he received his Master of Business Administration. He was an entrepreneur at heart and in the early 1980's he became a partner in Perry's Chuckwagon restaurant, Rieck Bros. Auto and Truck Service, and G & G Refuse. Rieck Bros. Auto and Truck Service built the first development in the TIF district on the south side of Mattoon. He was then employed with and retired from Lake Land College where he worked tirelessly for the college for twenty years and became Vice President for Business Services. He launched the formation of their Department of Public Safety, oversaw the construction of both phases of the West Building, and he was the visionary who initiated the campus wide project to convert nearly every building on campus to geothermal systems. He was an active member in the Illinois Community College Chief Financial Officers organization and served as president in 2008 was awarded ICCCF's CFO of the year in 2009. He was most passionate about the education processes at Lake Land College and the Rieck family hosted numerous foreign exchange students over two decades of his time at LLC.

After his LLC retirement, he embraced his partnership in Express Employment Professionals of Mattoon and Effingham, IL, which began in 2006 when his wife, Diane opened the business. For several years, he assisted in developing our local franchise to award winning status. Ray was passionate about people and giving back. He served many organizations throughout his years to include the boards of directors for The Mattoon Area Family YMCA, Mattoon Chamber of Commerce, Okaw Savings and Loan, The Greater Effingham County Chamber of Commerce, Sarah Bush Lincoln Health Systems Foundation, and Mission Lakes Condominium Association. He was dedicated to the growth of our local communities and enjoyed mentoring young professionals who he encouraged to develop and grow.
