



Roger Kent Bathe

Mattoon, IL – Roger K Bathe, age 69, of Mattoon, IL, passed away at 12:49 p.m., Sunday, June 5, 2016, at his residence.

The funeral service in his honor will begin at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, June 9, 2016 at First United Methodist Church, 1601 Charleston Ave, Mattoon, IL 61938. Pastor Kenneth Hutchens will officiate. Interment will follow in Oak Ridge Cemetery in Effingham IL. Visitation will be held Wednesday evening from 5:00-7:00 p.m., at Mitchell-Jerdan Funeral home, located at 1200 Wabash Avenue, Mattoon, IL.

Born in Decatur Illinois on August 9, 1946, Roger was the son of Jesse and Marjorie (Kenney) Bathe. He married Sharyl Erickson on April 29, 2006, in South Carolina. recently he was co-owner of luvracin.com, which is the largest racing website in the nation, and features local racing. He was also an Aflac Associate. He was past president of the Shelbyville Jaycees, and was a Jaycees senator. He was also a member of the Shelbyville Masonic Lodge. Roger had a lifelong love for racing, having raced wingless sprint cars. He was known as "Racin Rog" by many throughout the United States. Among highlights in his life was Petty Racing Experience where he drove 3 MPH below NASCAR average speeds.

A member First United Methodist Church, Roger's faith was an important part of his life. His faith and his family were a source of comfort and strength. He adored his family and cherished time spent with them more than anything.
