Timothy "Tim" James Walk, age 66 of Mattoon, IL passed away at 11:41 AM, Sunday, February 26, 2023, at Sarah Bush Lincoln Health Center in Mattoon, IL.

A funeral service in his honor will be held at 12:00 PM, Saturday, March 4, 2023, at Mitchell-Jerdan Funeral Home, 1200 Wabash Avenue, Mattoon, IL 61938. Pastor Lonnie Stewart will officiate. The visitation will be held from 10:00 AM until the time of service at the funeral home. Tim was a dedicated member of the Liberty Life Church of Mattoon, IL, holding the position of corporate board member and CFO and was an ordained minister with Faith Christian Fellowship International. 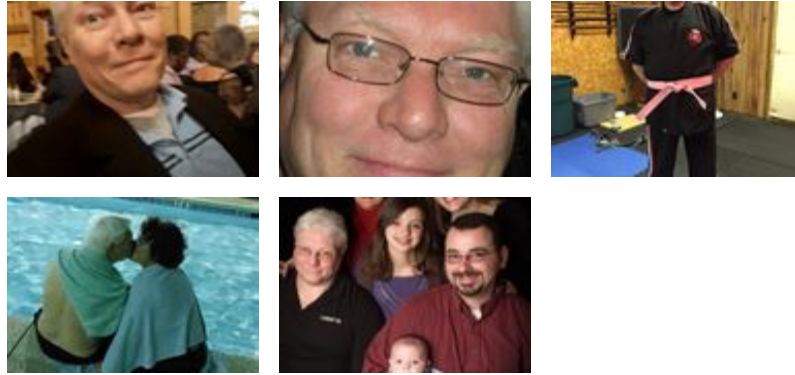

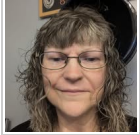
